As part of the car park wall brief, they didn't want the wall to be used as additional seating, or for empty bottles and beer glasses to be left sat on top of the walling



The now completed project, matches the materials that were used in phase 1 and are currently being installed in phase 2 of the Abergavenny town centre refurbishment, during photography numerous good comments were made by local residents on how this has added to the existing improvements currently being undertaken in Abergavenny.

Rather than using traditional copings to complete the wall, sawn and flamed pennant slabs were used installed at an angle to create a "Bishops Hat" coping detail, the flame finish applied to the pennant slabs gives a riven type finish. The whole wall has blended in very well and already looks like part of the historic town
