Bridgend County Borough Council Shared use paving slabs



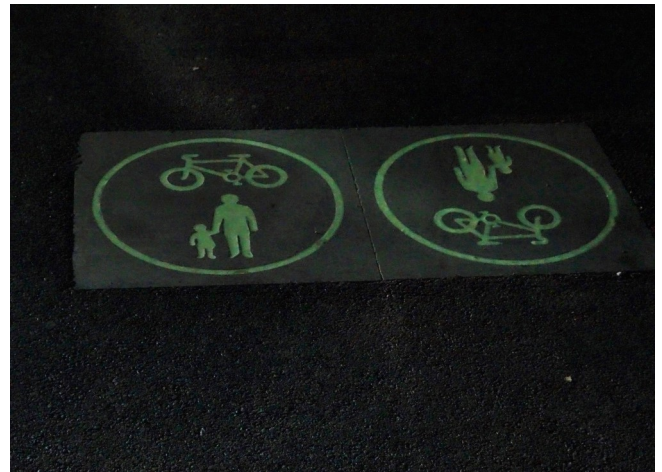
As part of the on-going improvements to enhance the experience for both pedestrians and cyclists in Bridgend. Bridgend County Borough Council engineers decided on their latest project NCN 885 Phase 3 to offer the very latest technology for clearly marking shared use areas. Traditional post mounted signs are not always that visible for cyclists whereas surface mounted signs are seen easily. The ability to use a traditional mixed use sign combining the Night Glow, glow in the dark technology has meant a sign that is visible both by day and night.



The daytime photo's were taken at 2.45pm on the 25th February 2019 with the night time taken on the same day at 7.45 pm. Although the photos look good and demonstrate the glow effect they probably look even better as a site visit. In view of the UK claims culture Bridgend can be seen to have gone beyond the norm to make sure that all pedestrians and cyclists are aware of the shared use area.
