With the construction of the new Nantgarw Cemetery, Caerphilly County Borough Council, were looking to a traditional Welsh stone laid in a coursed walling design, courses of 65/140 & 215mm were chosen in random lengths, the two smaller courses being split face and the 215mm flamed. The gate post pillars were built incorporating 450 x 225 x 100 dressed quoins, 675mm wide x random length (500-900mm) x 100mm copings, and large 675 x 675 x 100 pillar caps all with flamed top and sides

The new build also included a site management/office building, with the council wanting to maintain the same finish, the same walling stone and dressed quoins were used in conjunction with sawn and dressed heads and cills. All the stone was manufactured by Celtic Stone Ltd, Neath. The use of local stone also ticked all the boxes on the environmental front.

The overall project has a quality appearance, with the contractor and client delighted by the end result.
